The position involves maintaining the two-acre formal garden and other portions of the 22-acre property as outlined in the Property Management Plan. The Specialist will also help maintain trails at other Otsego Land Trust public access properties in Otsego County.

Qualifications

- Strong commitment to outdoor work and land conservation ethics and values.
- At least one season of direct experience in horticulture, gardening, and landscape maintenance.
- Knowledge of standard ornamental horticultural practices for seasonal and sustainable garden maintenance.
- Familiarity with plant species and culture, including nomenclature and taxonomy of native/non-native plants.
- Ability to engage effectively and positively with other staff, site vendors, visitors, and volunteers.
- Physical endurance to work outdoors for extended periods, tolerate weather conditions, and lift 40+ lbs.
- Proven ability to work productively and efficiently with minimal supervision.
- Willingness to follow safe work practices in areas with the potential for Lyme disease.
- Current driver's license with acceptable record, and an insured vehicle for driving to properties.
